Inauguration of a Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine and a Sanitary Napkin Disposal Machine

On the occasion of International Women's Day, as a sign of Increasing sensitivity to the needs of women, BVCITS has set up a Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine and Sanitary Napkin Disposal Machine in the women's common room in the Department of ECE. It is the first Institution in the town to install this type of amenity. The request to purchase the machines was instantly approved by the management of the Institution after discussion with the Internal Complaints Cell, approached with this novel idea. The machine, which dispenses a pack of a pad after inserting a five rupee coin in the slot. Sub-Inspector of Police, Amalapuram, Ms.L.Deva Sudha And MEO, Amalapuram,Smt. D. Vimala Kumari inaugurated the Vending Machine for Sanitary Napkins and The sanitary Napkin DisposalMachine in the Department of ECE in the campus for the welfare of its girl students. These kinds of machines are important in emergency situations. It is important to have such a facility readily available, especially in schools and colleges where the girls are new to the entire process of menstruation. It is important because going out and buying is not always an option. The girls need to have freedom of access to sanitary napkins whenever they need it. An initiative like this will ensure them freedom and they need not go around asking for it. It will empower all Lady Faculty and Girl Students to save them from the trouble of asking friends every now and then when we get their periods unannounced. The installation of Sanitary napkin disposal machine reduces the pollution created during decomposing of these sanitary napkins.
